

Clinton Newberry Natural Gas Authority
Board of Directors Regular Meeting
February 26, 2026

The Clinton Newberry Natural Gas Authority Board of Directors met on Thursday, February 26, 2026 in a regular meeting at 6:00pm in the Edward Kyzer Newberry Firehouse Conference Center. Members present were Board Chair Mr. Randy Randall, Board Vice-Chair Mr. Foster Senn, Board Secretary Mr. Danny Cook, Board Member Mr. Gary Kuykendall, Board Member Mr. Lemont Glasgow, Board Member Mr. David DuBose, Board Member Mr. Gregg Summer, Authority General Manager Mr. James Capps, and Authority Finance Director Mr. Phillip Allison. Also present were Authority Counsel Mr. Frank Partridge, Authority Assistant General Manager Mr. Bob Simpson, Mr. Rich Klaus of IGS Energy, members of the public, and members of the media.

Mr. Randall established the presence of a quorum and called the meeting to order.

Mr. Glasgow gave the invocation.

The first item on the agenda was the approval of the minutes from the January 27 and February 5, 2026 meetings. Mr. Kuykendall moved to approve the minutes as presented. Mr. DuBose seconded the motion. There was no discussion and the motion was unanimously adopted.

Mr. Senn welcomed and recognized members of the City of Newberry Fire and Police departments, thanking them for their service to the community. He also recognized their recent response to a cut gas line on Wilson Road and the response of the Clinton Police and Fire to an accident in Clinton which damaged the meter, causing a leak at a customer's location.

The next item on the agenda was a presentation from Mr. Rich Klaus of IGS Energy. Mr. Klaus gave information related to nationwide industry impacts of the late January winter storms and answered questions presented by the Board members. Mr. Klaus indicated that in his 30+ years in the industry he had never seen a situation such as what occurred.

The next item on the agenda was a presentation by Mr. Capps on the impacts to the Authority of the late January winter storms. Mr. Capps began by letting members of the public know that payment arrangements are available and that automatic payments have been extended to allow for time to make arrangements if needed. He explained the process of gas purchasing followed by the Authority for many years. He also presented areas of potential change in both purchasing and communication that the Authority has identified because of the events surrounding the January storms. Mr. Capps closed by affirming the Authority's commitment to search for more cost-saving measures as it moves forward.

The next item on the agenda was a time of public input. Cards were passed out to members of the public who requested to submit questions to Mr. Capps. After answering presented questions, members of the public were invited to continue submissions with answers to be provided by email, social media, and/or the company website.

With no further business to come before the Board and without objection Mr. Randall declared the meeting adjourned. The meeting was adjourned at 7:28pm.
